- Banking: understanding accounts, fees, and digital tools
- Managing debt: student loans, credit cards, and repayment strategies
- Insurance: protecting health, property, and financial stability
- Real Estate: the realities of renting and mortgages
- Saving and Investing: building wealth with purpose and confidence

While everyone walked away with new financial knowledge, a few lucky participants snagged prizes, including botanical Lego sets, board games, and one participant walked away with a Nintendo Switch 2.

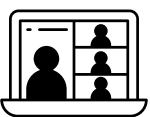
